On behalf of The Consortium of PA Education, we would like to thank you for being a clinical preceptor for our Physician Assistant students. You are a valued member of our teaching team, and we recognize the great efforts and added responsibility that being a clinical preceptor carries. Our students are extremely satisfied with their clinical rotation experiences, and we wish to share their opinions with you.

After 5 years of collecting data, we are grateful to have sufficient data to provide you access to a collated, evaluation report, generated from the anonymous feedback from your students. 
## INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRECEPTORS: HOW TO GENERATE EDUCATOR PERFORMANCE REPORTS

- 1. LOG IN:
  - i. Go to the E\*Value website page at: https://ca.e-value.net/index.cfm
  - ii. Login with your username and password (provided in the email).



## 2. SELECT THE AGGREGATE REPORT:

i. Click on the grey tab at the top "Reports"



ii. Look for the black text heading on the left side of the screen:


**Evaluation Educator Reports**, and select either of the following in blue text:

(Once the report is generated, you will be able to toggle between the numeric scores (performance) and comments.

iii. You will now see a page that looks something like this:



Click on to generate your report. From the top right corner of the report, you can choose to print or have the system send you an email with the port as a PDF.
