JOB SUMMARY:	The Physician Assistant (PA) will work under the direct supervision of an immediately available Attending General Internal Medicine (GIM) Physician within a multidisciplinary team in an ambulator care clinic and inpatient Clinical Te1aching Unit (CTU). The PA will play a major role in facilitating consistent application of clinical protocols and continuity of care and will also work alongside the GIN Physician to see outpatient consults. Cases will be reviewed and discussed and a co-management plan will be developed. The PA will provide a full range of physician assistant services in accordance with privileges granted, request consultation or referral with appropriate physicians, clinics, or other health care resources as indicated, order diagnostic tests as applicable, prescribe and dispense medications as delineated by the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee.
