We are looking to hire a PA to fulfill a need for our patients in our academic vascular surgery practice. The role will be primarily clinic based, in a stand alone ambulatory clinic - East Toronto Vascular Clinic - with two academic surgeons. Our clinic serves the entire spectrum of arterial and venous vascular disease, and also serves the needs of vascular patients with non healing lower extremity wounds.

The role is at East Toronto Vascular Clinic in our surveillance program, wound clinic and research program supervised by Dr. Andrew Dueck and Dr. Ahmed Kayssi

- Vascular surveillance: Assess patients (history and physical exam), track ultrasound and test results.
- Wound Clinic: Assess patients (history and physical exam) assist in wound procedure/dressing
- Participating in our research program

More about ETVC:

Our clinic currently provides clinical assessments, wound treatments and dressings, and vascular doppler ultrasound testing for patients across the Greater Toronto Area and southern Ontario. East Toronto Vascular Clinic has 4 clinic days per week, 1 wound clinic every other week, and vascular ultrasound testing every day. Our clinic serves 500-600 visits per month and in addition to clinical and testing services, we are actively engaged in wound care education and research. We have on site vascular surgeons, a wound care nurse, off loading services (customized footwear for patients with wounds), vascular ultrasound technologists and admin support.

We participated in the clinical placement of PA students and therefore have real world experience of integrating a PA into our practice in terms of physical space and administrative flow. We have a desk and workstation (computer, phone, etc.) dedicated to our PA program. We have dedicated one clinical exam room to the PA to assess patients, with the vascular surgeon utilizing the other two clinical exam rooms. Our PA will integrate into our EMR and ultrasound PACS system to review past patient results and encounters, and record current patient encounters. Our EMR supports an internal messaging and template system which in addition to direct in person on site supervision, will be used to provide detailed direction and algorithms for patient care.

We are certain that a PA will have a tremendous impact on our operations and on patient care. A PA member of the team will allow us to better coordinate the delivery of services, our vascular surveillance program and our wound clinic.
